

2010 PROJECTS

Throop Borough will undertake the following major projects this year.

1. **George Street Curb & Sidewalk**

The project will include the installation of new concrete curbs and sidewalks along the 300, 400, 500, 600, 700, 800 and 900 blocks of George Street. In conjunction with the new sidewalks, portions of the sanitary sewer system will be replaced in areas of the 300, 400, 600 and 700 blocks. Portions of the sanitary sewer service laterals, which cross under the sidewalk areas, will be upgraded and cleanouts will be installed between the curb and property lines to service each property within the project area. Storm water inlet boxes will be upgraded at the intersection of State Street and the intersection of Clark Street. The project is expected to begin in late March or early April 2010. A contract for the work has been awarded to Scartelli Construction Services of Taylor, PA at a cost of \$865,440.00. This project is being financed in part by the United States Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration under the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act instituted by the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act and continued under the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century and in part through local funds. Any property owner within the project area who is contemplating a new driveway installation should contact the Street Commissioner in order to make the proper adjustments to the curb and walk at the proposed drive way location.

2. **Mary Street Sanitary Sewer Reconstruction Project**

The project will include the replacement of the sanitary sewer system along the entire length of Mary Street. Included within the scope of work is replacement of the 8" sanitary sewer main and the connected service laterals located within the right-of-way. Cleanout boxes will be installed on each service lateral along the tree lawn area of the project for future access by the Borough. The street will be resurfaced as part of the project. The project is expected to begin in late March or early April, 2010. A contract has been awarded for the work to Popple Construction of Laflin, PA at a cost of \$130,036.00. This project is being financed by a grant from the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development under the administration of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development through Lackawanna County on behalf of Throop Borough.

3. **Goodman Street Sanitary Sewer Reconstruction Project**

This project will include the replacement of the sanitary sewer system along the entire length of Goodman Street. Included within the scope of work for this project is replacement of the 8" sanitary sewer main and the connected service laterals located within the right-of-way. Cleanout boxes will be installed on each service lateral along the tree lawn area of the project for future

access by the Borough. The street will be resurfaced under the project. The project is expected to begin in late April or early May, 2010. Solicitation of bid proposals for this project is expected to occur in March, 2010. This project will be financed in part by a grant from the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development under the administration of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development through Lackawanna County on behalf of Throop Borough, in part by funds allocated by Pennsylvania American Water Company for pavement restoration costs associated with the recent water main upgrade project and in part with local funds.
