ORDINANCE NUMBER 5 OF 2022

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING TRUCKS OVER 40 FEET IN LENGTH ON EDGAR STREET CONSISTENT WITH REILLY ASSOCIATES REVISED TRAFFIC ASSESSMENT DATED SEPTEMBER 8, 2021

WHEREAS, Throop Borough Council passed a Motion to have Reilly Associates perform a Traffic and Engineering Study on Edgar Street, restricting trucks over 40 feet in length; and

WHEREAS, Reilly Associates completed its Traffic Assessment and issued its report dated July 30, 2021, revised September 8, 2021; and

WHEREAS, it is Throop Borough Council's intention to adopt the findings contained in Reilly's Edgar Street Traffic Assessment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF THROOP AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Tractor-trailer restrictions Traffic signs will be installed on Edgar Street and any other street necessary to enforce this Ordinance prohibiting trucks over 40 feet long (except local deliveries) so that potentially unsafe traffic conflicts associated with turning movements of tractor trailers can be avoided.
- 2. No other recommendations stated in the Reilly Associated Report dated September 8, 2021, are adopted. Only the no tractor trailers over 40-foot-long restrictions.

SECTION 1.

If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The Borough of Throop reserves the right to amend this Ordinance or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Ordinance and the effective administration thereof.

SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.

SECTION 3.

This Ordinance is enacted by the Council of the Borough of Throop under the authority of the Act of the Legislative, as amended, December 12, 1990, P.L. 1994, No. 220, and any other applicable law arising under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
