

BOROUGH OF THROOP
ORDINANCE NO. 11 OF 2005

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF THROOP PROHIBITING THE
PLACEMENT OF REFUSE FOR CURBSIDE REMOVAL OF REFUSE
GENERATED OUTSIDE OF THE BOROUGH OF THROOP; AND ALSO
SETTING FORTH WEIGHT LIMITATIONS ON CONTAINERS**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Throop is a duly authorized political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, The Borough of Throop presently does not have a refuse collection fee and as a result certain non-residents are depositing or disposing of waste within the Borough and certain residents are depositing for pickup waste generated outside of the Borough of Throop; and

WHEREAS, certain residents have set out containers weighing well in excess of Forty (40) pounds; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the health and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Throop to place certain limitations on the pickup of refuse within the Borough of Throop; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That no person shall deposit within the Borough of Throop for refuse collection any refuse generated or created outside of the municipal boundaries or any refuse created by any commercial enterprise.

Section 2. That no person shall place for refuse pickup any item and/or any container weighing in excess of Forty (40) pounds, excluding white goods.

Section 3. That all refuse for pick-up shall be placed on the curbside on the day scheduled for collection.

Section 4. Any person who shall violate any provision of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$600.00, plus costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for a term not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this article continues shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 5: All Ordinances or parts or ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval.
