ORDINANCE # 7 of 1995

BOROUGH OF THROOP PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF THROOP, LACKAWANNA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PROHIBITING PLACEMENT OF REFUSE FOR CURBSIDE REMOVAL BY INDIVIDUALS AND ENTITIES NOT RESIDENTS OF THROOP.

WHEREAS, It has come to the attention of Borough Council that certain non residents of Throop have left refuse within Throop Borough for pickup by Throop Borough; and

WHEREAS, This practice results in increased cost of refuse pick-up to residents of this community and also constitutes an unacceptable burden to the employees of the Borough and hampers the ability of the Borough to efficiently collect the refuse of its citizens, it is hereby resolved

THAT: The dropping of refuse by non residents in the Borough of Throop is hereby strictly prohibited; and

It is hereby resolved that it is strictly prohibited for Throop residents to accept or acquiesce in allowing any non resident to leave garbage or refuse in Throop for removal.

Violation of this Ordinance carries a fine of \$300.00. Each violation constitutes a separate offense.

ADOPTION

This Ordinance shall take full force and effect from the date of passage.
