AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 7 OF 1999

AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 7 OF THE BOROUGH OF THROOP
REGULATING HOURS WHEN RESIDENCES/BUSINESS OWNERS MAY PLACE
GARBAGE FOR WEEKLY PICK UP AND REMOVAL OF EMPTY
CANS/CONTAINERS FOLLOWING COLLECTION OF GARBAGE

WHEREAS, on February 22, 1999, the Borough of Throop Council enacted Ordinance No. 7, of 1999; and

WHEREAS, by motion of the Throop Borough Council, which passed on March 11, 1999 Ordinance No. 7 of 1999 is to be amended; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Borough of Throop that Ordinance No. 7 of 1999 shall be amended to include recycling containers that residents\business owners are prohibited from placing at there designated areas more than twelve (12) hours from the date of collection and all recycling cans/containers must be removed from their designated areas no later than twelve (12) hours following collection.


SECTION 1. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not effect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The Borough of Throop reserves the right to amend this Ordinance or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Ordinance and the effective administration thereof.


SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance amendment is enacted by the Council of the Borough of Throop under the authority of P.L. 1194, No. 220, §1, 53 P.S. §46006, and any other applicable law arising under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.


