BOROUGH OF THROOP ORDINANCE NO. 7 OF 1999

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF THROOP REGULATING HOURS WHEN RESIDENCES/BUSINESS OWNERS MAY PLACE GARBAGE FOR WEEKLY PICK UP AND REMOVAL OF EMPTY CANS/CONTAINERS FOLLOWING COLLECTION OF GARBAGE

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of Throop Borough Council that the residents/business owners are placing garbage at designated areas well before collection; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of Throop Borough Council that residents/business owners are leaving empty garbage cans and containers at designated areas well after garbage has been collected; and

WHEREAS, In order to provide for the proper management, care and control of the Borough of Throop and to provide the proper health, safety and welfare of the Borough of Throop and the citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Throop that residents\business owners are prohibited from placing garbage at there designated areas more than twelve (12) hours from the date of collection and all cans/containers must be removed from their designated areas no later than twelve (12) hours following collection.

SECTION 1. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not effect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The Borough of Throop reserves the right to amend this Ordinance or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the

best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Ordinance and the effective administration thereof.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval.

SECTION 3.

This Ordinance amendment is enacted by the Council of the

Borough of Throop under the authority of P.L. 1194, No. 220, §1, 53 P.S. §46006, and any other applicable law arising under the law of the G.

other applicable law arising under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

SECTION 4. Any resident/business owner who fails to comply with the terms

of this Ordinance will be assessed a Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollar fine for every violation.
