

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF THROOP AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY AND WITH THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME AS FOLLOWS:

1. That upon a snowfall of any dimension or magnitude, the Mayor of the Borough of Throop may proclaim a snow emergency.
2. That upon such proclamation that a snow emergency exists, the following rules shall be in effect.
 - (a) There will be absolutely no parking on the even-numbered sides of all of the streets in the Borough of Throop pending the completion of a snow plow run through that area.
 - (b) That immediately upon the passage of the snow plow through that area, parking of all vehicles will then shift to the odd-numbered side of the street.
3. Any vehicle parked in violation of the ordinance will be towed away at the expense of the owner and in addition thereof there will be a penalty imposed of a fine not exceeding Ten (10.00) Dollars and/or imprisonment not exceeding Ten (10) days.
4. It will be the duty and responsibility of the owners of vehicles parked in the Borough of Throop to determine whether or not a snow emergency exists by contacting the Throop Municipal Building, Radio the press, TV stations or any other news media
5. After completion of snow plow runs parking will be permitted as heretofore.
