## THROOP BOROUGH ORDINANCE #19 OF 1999

## AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 15 OF 1994 A RECYCLING ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, on July 25, 1994 the Borough of Throop Council enacted Ordinance No. 15, of 1994; and

WHEREAS, by motion of the Throop Borough Council, which passed on November 9, 1999 Ordinance No. 15 of 1994 is to be amended; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Borough of Throop that Section 3-E of Ordinance No. 15 of 1994 shall be amended to read as follows: Each commercial and/or institutional establishment and community activity which does not receive municipal solid waste collection service by the Borough or its agent shall separate and store the following recyclable post consumer materials in receptacles, and shall provide for collection thereof, but not less often than once per month: high grade office paper, corrugated paper, aluminum cans, glass and plastic bottles and jars, metallic cans, newspaper and other marketable grades of paper, and may recycle other materials listed elsewhere in this Ordinance. Each entity shall provide monthly to the Borough, written documentation in a form prescribed by the Borough, of the type of material recycled and the weight of such material recycled. The remaining sections of Ordinance No. 15 of 1994 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 1. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not effect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance so long as it

remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The Borough of Throop reserves the right to amend this Ordinance or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Ordinance and the effective administration thereof.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance amendment is enacted by the Council of the Borough of Throop under the authority of P.L. 1194, No. 220, §1, 53 P.S. §46006, and any other applicable law arising under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
