Got Drugs?

The Throop Police Department is pleased to offer the opportunity for the community to anonymously get rid of unused, unwanted, expired and potentially dangerous prescription and non-prescription medications.

A permanent drug take back container is now installed outside of the Throop Police Department located at 201 Charles Street.

This permanent take back container allows not only borough residents, but everyone, to safely and securely dispose of these medications on a daily basis. Acceptable items include prescription and over the counter medications in pill, liquid and cream forms. Sharpies and syringes are not accepted. The removal of medications from our homes not only allows these medications to be disposed of in an environmentally safe manner, it reduces the opportunity for our family members and others to get access to these potentially harmful medications. 7 days a week, 24 hours a day, this container is available.
